- 2016 Electronic Annual Reports
  - o Overdue, submit ASAP if you have not already!
  - o Enforcement and fees are forthcoming
- Lead Service Line Inventory
  - o Requirement for Community Water Systems (CWSs) only
  - o Water system responsibilities extend to the meter, but if you become aware of lead lines or other issues beyond the meter, you should inform the homeowner
  - o Identification of lead lines or possible lead lines must be completed by July 1<sup>st</sup>, 2018

- Federal RTCR finalized in 2016, California RTCR still in development
